Subject: Amount of military equipment sent to Ukraine by each Member State

In statements to the media following the Foreign Affairs Council meeting on 14 November, the Vice-President / High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy said:

'I think I can say that at least EUR 8 billion in military equipment have already been provided to Ukraine by the European Union and the Member States. It is about 45% of the effort done by the United States, so it is not negligible. We are not talking about EUR 3.1 billion, but about EUR 8 billion on military support.1'

1. Can the Vice-President / High Representative provide disaggregated data on the amount of military equipment that each Member State has sent to Ukraine since the start of the illegal aggression by Russia?
