Subject: 'Safe Gas for a Safe Winter' initiative

The war against Ukraine has painfully highlighted the importance of rapidly achieving independence from fossil fuels. The Commission 'Safe Gas for a Safe Winter' initiative highlights the need to reduce gas dependency and sets out a clear plan of action to achieve this.

The Commission's new REPowerEU programme accordingly contains a number of ambitious targets for the use of heat pumps as a possible means of achieving a major reduction in gas dependency. However, in order to achieve these targets, twice as many new heat pumps would need to be installed over the next five years.

- 1. Can the Commission say how it plans to step up the manufacture and use of heat pumps?
- 2. To what extent have the various Commission directorates-general and policy departments coordinated their actions under the REPowerEU programme?
- 3. Has the Commission carried out a preliminary assessment of the impact of its measures on heat pump manufacturers?
