Subject: Failure to meet the objectives of the Common Fisheries Policy (CFP)

The current Common Fisheries Policy (CFP) has failed to meet the desired aims of many communities dependent on fisheries such as Galicia, a fishing nation whose fleet has been gradually dismantled as a result of implementation of the CFP, falling from 4 600 registered vessels in 2012 to 4 237 units today.

The European Commission will soon have the perfect opportunity to engage in an ambitious review of the CFP, amending it to strike the right balance between social, economic and environmental sustainability.

Is the Commission going to review the CFP in 2023 in line with the wishes of Europe's various types of fleet and by coastal communities such as Galicia, as transmitted to it by the European Parliament?
