Subject: Measures to combat youth emigration from Galicia

Thousands of young people continue to move from Galicia to other parts of Europe due to the lack of alternatives and precarious working and living conditions. This is not mobility per se but a drain of professional and university talent in a nation that is already facing a serious ageing problem. In a number of previous questions I already warned the Commission about this problem, which represents a huge loss of talent for the universities and training centres these young people have attended and for Galicia's production sector in general.

1. Is the Commission aware of this situation?
2. Will the Commission take measures using ordinary and extraordinary funds to combat this 'brain drain', which forces so many young Galicians and other young Europeans to leave the place where they were born and educated?
