Subject: Second call for proposals for the PERTE for electric and connected vehicles

On 13 July 2021, the Spanish Government approved the first of the Strategic Projects for Economic Recovery and Transformation (PERTE) dedicated to electric and connected vehicles (VEC) as part of the NextGenerationEU programme¹.

The government has invested EUR 4.295 billion of public funds in this PERTE. However, it has only finalised calls for proposals amounting to EUR 1.467 billion. In other words, it has implemented just 37% of the VEC PERTE. Large car manufacturers, such as the Stellantis factory in Vigo, have barely benefited from this PERTE.

On 24 October 2022, the Spanish Prime Minister announced a second call for proposals for the PERTE for electric and connected vehicles². To date, neither the Prime Minister nor the Ministry of Industry, Trade and Tourism has provided any further information in this regard.

What information does the Commission have on this second call for proposals for the VEC PERTE?
