Subject: Roadworthiness package

According to the 2023 Commission work programme, the roadworthiness package will be revised in Q3 rather than Q1 as initially planned.

Postponing the roadworthiness package will delay inspections of vehicles in line with technological progress. This in turn may pose risks in terms of safety and sustainability as well as being at odds with the Commission's aspiration that legislation keep pace with technological developments.

1. What are the reasons for Commission's decision to delay the publication of the roadworthiness package?
2. How does the Commission, despite the delay, intend to keep pace with technological developments, i.e. ensuring timely and adequate inspections in the interest of safety and sustainability?
