Fast fashion is becoming an environmental problem Globally, only 3% of textiles are recycled. The Integral Institute surveyed 1 506 people to find out more about the clothing habits of Austrians<sup>1</sup>. One in two people buy their clothes from large fashion retailers or online stores. Most people think it is important that clothing is durable and functional, but this is not the reality. 20% of global water pollution can be attributed to the textile industry.
