Subject: Accessibility of food products and dangerous products

The accessibility of food products and dangerous products in the EU is currently limited for blind people, since the use of labels written in Braille on such products is entirely at the manufacturer's discretion. The fact that there is no obligation for the manufacturers of food products or dangerous products to include a label in Braille is a serious problem for blind people, since it limits their independence.

In light of this:

- 1. How can the Commission guarantee the accessibility of these types of products for blind people?
- 2. Is the Commission considering any measures to oblige the manufacturers of food products and dangerous products to include Braille labelling?
