Subject: EU signs

When the US Government funds projects abroad, the signs posted beside the projects read 'US AID FROM THE AMERICAN PEOPLE'.

When the EU funds projects, the signs posted beside the projects say 'Funded by the European Union'.

Does the Commission agree that new EU signs saying 'Funded by the citizens of the European Union' would make the connection between EU programmes and funds, and the citizens who finance them, more visible, increase citizens' identification with the EU programmes and funds they finance, and strengthen the sense of community and solidarity among citizens across the Member States?
