Subject: Labour Migration Platform

The Commissioner for Home Affairs, Ylva Johansson, and the Commissioner for Jobs and Social Rights, Nicolas Schmit, recently held the first meeting of the Labour Migration Platform in Brussels, with the involvement of migration and employment experts from the Member States.

The platform is expected to meet at regular intervals in order to 'enhance cooperation and progress in the area of labour migration to the EU', and 'depending on the topics discussed, relevant experts and organisations will be asked to join in addition to Commission and Member States' representatives'¹.

1. Does the Commission have more information to give regarding the structure of this platform?
2. Is it able to specify which organisations and experts may be associated with this platform?
3. Is it aware of the damage that could be done to third countries that are deprived of the skills that are being attracted and welcomed into Europe?
