Subject: Publication of information regarding the final recipients of recovery and resilience funding

Following pressure from the European Parliament for increased transparency and accountability in the management of the recovery and resilience facility and in the wake of multiple petitions and publications protesting at the withholding of information by many Member States, Regulation (EU) 2023/435<sup>1</sup> has added a new Article 25a to the recovery and resilience regulation laying down rules for the publication of information regarding final recipients. In particular, it stipulates the creation of an easy-to-use public portal in each Member State containing data on the 100 final recipients receiving the highest amount of funding, to be updated twice a year. At the same time, the Commission is required to centralise Member States' public portals and publish the data in the recovery and resilience scoreboard.

This regulation applies directly to compliance with the above obligations on the part of the Member States and the Commission, and the highest possible guarantees of transparency and accountability must be provided regarding the management of this unprecedented volume of European funding.

In view of this:

1. Has the Commission set a specific deadline for Member States to meet their obligations to post this information on user-friendly public portals? If so, what is this deadline?
2. When will the Commission have its central portal up and running?
