Subject: Eurodac registration

According to media reports, a significant number of asylum seekers reaching the German border are unregistered in Eurodac, despite Member States' obligation to ensure that all applicants for asylum are registered at their point of entry into the EU.

1. What efforts is the Commission making to ensure agreed registration procedures are followed in all Member States?
2. How does this failure to register asylum seekers affect migration planning, particularly if up to 75 % of asylum seekers fail to register?
3. What are the security implications of this failure to register?
