Question for written answer E-000740/2023 to the Commission Rule 138 Sergio Berlato (ECR)

Subject: Increase in excess mortality in Europe: we want clarity

On the basis of the available data published by Eurostat, in the past few months there has been a sharp increase in excess mortality in Europe over a time frame that coincides with the administration of vaccines against Covid-19.

Despite the increase in the number of adverse reactions, some of them fatal, that are occurring more or less everywhere, there would seem to be a tendency on the part of the health authorities to minimise or deny outright any kind of correlation between these adverse reactions and inoculation with the experimental genetic substances improperly called 'Covid-19 vaccines'.

In view of the above, can the Commission clarify:

- whether it intends to arrange in-depth studies to provide greater clarity about the correlation between inoculation with these putative Covid-19 vaccines and the numerous adverse reactions, some of them fatal, that have occurred and are still occurring, including within the territory of the European Community;
- whether it does not feel, given the changed epidemiological situation in Europe compared with
 the initial phase and in the light of the worrying number of adverse reactions that are being
 recorded, that it is necessary to suspend the authorisations for use of these putative Covid-19
 vaccines throughout the territory of the Union.

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
