Subject: Frontex reconnaissance in connection with the maritime emergency off the Italian

province of Crotone

At 4:57 (UTC) on 25 February 2023, the Italian Maritime Emergency Control Centre signalled to all craft in the Ionian Sea that a vessel was in distress. Some hours later, that vessel crashed against rocks in rough seas and broke up; dozens of people died. According to reports, Frontex had spotted the vessel many hours before the disaster occurred.

- 1. How did Frontex trace the vessel in question, and what satellite-based or aircraft-based technology for detecting emissions from VHF and X-band maritime radiocommunication equipment or satellite telephones was used to do so?
- 2. What Frontex aircraft or drones stationed in Italy, Malta or Crete observed the vessel subsequently, and at what time, and to what authorities was the vessel's position reported?
- 3. What aircraft or drones used by the Frontex Aerial Surveillance Service have technology to locate mobile or satellite telephones on board, and who is the manufacturer of that equipment?

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
