Subject: Greek railway safety reports

In her answer to Question E-001049/2022 by Petros Kokkalis, MEP (19 May 2022), Commissioner Valean observed that 'recent safety reports do not suggest any increased safety risk stemming from train operations on the Greek rail network.'<sup>1</sup>In view of the Commissioner's reply and the recent fatal accident in the Tempi area in Greece:

1. Can the Commission specify precisely to which reports the Commissioner is referring? Who wrote them and where can they be found?
2. Does it verify the accuracy of the safety reports provided by the Member States?
