1. Does the Commission share the view that – especially after major paedophile cases such as Dutroux, Demmink and Epstein – we must be vigilant to prevent paedophilia, child abuse and child exploitation?
2. Does the Commission agree that such images of naked children, child abuse and child mutilation are disgusting and disturbing, and that such exhibitions at least suggest that this disgustingly morbid art is being promoted?
