## Subject: Mutual recognition of eco-stickers

Several Member States of the European Union have introduced environmental or emission stickers in addition to toll stickers – this is the case for Denmark, Spain and Germany but also Norway. They are used to regulate vehicle access to various low-emission zones.

This can entail a considerable administrative burden for EU citizens travelling within the Union. In addition, in practical terms, it may be difficult to find enough space on the windscreen for all the ecostickers along with the toll stickers. The common emissions standards in the EU mean mean that comparability for cars within the EU should not be a problem.

- 1. Is the Commission planning to implement a common system of eco-stickers or rules for the mutual recognition of eco-stickers throughout the EU?
- 2. If not, why not, and what alternatives does it envisage?
