Subject: Mercosur Agreement

The Mercosur Agreement is a trade agreement between the EU and the South American countries Argentina, Brazil, Paraguay and Uruguay¹. It aims to facilitate trade between the parties by eliminating or reducing tariffs and barriers to trade. It covers a wide range of areas, including trade in goods and services, intellectual property, investment and public procurement.
