EN E-001050/2023 Answer given by Ms Simson on behalf of the European Commission (5.6.2023)

Spain submitted to the Commission an application for a derogation for Spain's non-mainland territories pursuant to Article 66 of Directive (EU) 2019/944¹ and Article 64 of Regulation (EU) 2019/943² on the internal market for electricity. The application included a request for a derogation from Article 54 of Directive (EU) 2019/944 and referred specifically to the Chira-Soria pumped-storage facility in Gran Canaria, and to future pumped-storage facilities owned by the system operator. The Commission is currently assessing all relevant facts and aims to issue a decision as soon as possible.

The regional authorities have issued a positive Environmental Impact Statement for the project Chira Soria³ that includes the assessment of the implications of the project on Natura 2000 sites⁴. From the information available in the statement, it is not possible to conclude whether the need to install the infrastructure in the 'priority area for conservation' of the site 'Macizo de Tauro II' has been duly justified in line with the site's management plan and the Habitats⁵ and Birds⁶ Directives requirements.

Following a Parliamentary petition⁷ on this project, the Commission asked the Canary Islands authorities for information on the implementation of the appropriate assessment of this project⁸. The Commission is currently assessing the information received from the authorities.
