Subject: Biodiversity

In its biodiversity strategy, the Commission calls for 30% of land and marine areas to be taken out of use and made into conservation areas. This raises a number of questions:

- 1. To what extent does the Commission consider a quota system to be sensible when the conditions of the EU's land vary so greatly from region to region?
- 2. To what extent would the implementation of these demands be compatible with the right to property?
- 3. The right to property is constitutionally enshrined within most legal systems. Changing constitutional laws in Austria would necessitate an increased quorum and possibly even a referendum. Would the Commission actively support such referendums?
