Subject: Compensation for Israel's destruction of EU-funded projects and schools in Palestine

In its reply to Written Question E-002844/2022/rev.1<sup>1</sup>, the Commission states that 'on a number of occasions, Israel was requested to return, or compensate for, EU-funded assets that have been demolished, dismantled or confiscated.'

Please can the Commission specify:

1. How many times have such requests been made over the past five to ten years?
2. How many times has Israel effectively paid financial compensation for the EU-funded assets it has demolished, dismantled or confiscated?
3. On average, what percentage of the damage or loss of value to EU-funded assets has Israel paid compensation for?
