Subject: Gas Storage

The recently published report from the Commission on certain aspects concerning gas storage, based on Regulation (EU) 2017/1938 of the European Parliament and of the Council, does not include 'an overview of the measures taken by Member States to fulfill the storage obligations', as is required in the regulation.

Recognising that the report is of limited use to Parliament in its current state, will the Commission:

- Indicate which Member States have, in its view, satisfied the requirements set out in the regulation.
- Publish details of the measures that these Member States have put in place that it views as meeting the requirements set out in the regulation.
- Outline the actions it intends to take in cases where Member States have failed to adopt measures as required by the regulation.
