According to the Eurobarometer survey of January/February 2023, 45 % of EU citizens do not trust the European Union and 41 % do not know their rights as EU citizens. However, the survey also indicated that 61 % of EU citizens feel attached to the EU and 69 % want to know more about their rights, clearly indicating that people are open to the European idea and are willing to learn about the European Union and its benefits.
