Subject: Adoption of measures to encourage young people to engage in European political life

The EU Youth Dialogue was asked in its 9th cycle to encourage young people to engage in European political life.

Indeed, at the Youth Conference, several recommendations were made on how to better integrate young Europeans into decision-making processes, including by promoting intergenerational dialogue and establishing consultative youth councils.

The Swedish Presidency of the Council of the EU supports the initiative and states that more attention should be paid to the dialogue with young people, calling on the Member States to integrate a youth perspective into all policy areas.

In view of the above:

1. Will the Commission accept the recommendations put forward by the Youth Conference and the Council of the European Union?
2. Will it allocate new resources to innovative projects to integrate young people into European political life?
