Subject: Political corruption in the PSOE using EU funds via a public international cooperation

foundation (FIIAPP)

Both the Anti-Fraud Office and the European Public Prosecutor's Office have intervened in the Mediator Case, a saga of political corruption, sexual exploitation and drug use in the Spanish Socialist Workers' Party (PSOE), paid for with EU funds. Among those arrested are a member of the Spanish Parliament and the director of the EU's GAR-SI SAHEL project. This project is financed by the European Commission and managed by FIIAPP, a public foundation chaired by Ms Calviño, Vice-President of the Spanish Government and former high-ranking Commission official. It has an annual budget of EUR 67 million, most of which comes from the EU.

- 1. How, when and what checks does the Commission carry out, given that a political corruption scandal involving the use of EU funds is once again being uncovered by third parties?
- 2. When Ms Calviño was the Commission's Director-General for Budget, what links did she have with FIIAPP?
- 3. What is the Commission's view of the fact that the Spanish Government poised to take over the presidency of the EU Council is engulfed in a further case of misappropriation of EU funds by the PSOE, as with the ERE scandal?
