The EU is funding a 'Queer Camp' with taxpayers' money Subject:

As part of the EU Youth Strategy – the aims of which are to encourage young people to get involved in democracy and play an active role in society - the EU is funding a 'Queer Camp'. This summer camp with a focus on sexual orientation is to take place in Berlin between 24 July and 7 August 2023. It will include a workshop on learning to become a drag-queen or drag-king.

It appears that this LGBTQ+ camp will be organised and funded by the European Solidarity Corps, a body belonging to the Commission with a budget of EUR 1 billion for 2021-2027¹. It will also receive EU funds from a range of programmes, including Erasmus+.

- 2. If so, can it please state its arguments for doing so?
- Does it not consider, furthermore, that the organisation of events focusing primarily on one sexual orientation is in itself a form of discrimination?
