Subject: Setting up operational contact points for search-and-rescue operations

EU Member States and associated Schengen Area countries are to set up operational search-and-rescue (SAR) points of contact, which, according to the SAR Contact Group, could be located within national maritime rescue coordination centres. Their stated purpose is to exchange information in a systematic, timely and detailed fashion, with a view to an enhanced situational picture, and to ensure, overall, smooth coordination and cooperation between all relevant actors.

- 1. Which Member States will have designated an operational SAR point of contact by 15 July 2023 and where, in each case, will the contact point be located?
- 2. How are the points of contact going to ensure that, as has been called for, information is exchanged in a systematic, timely and detailed fashion, with a view to an enhanced situational picture, and that there is, overall, smooth coordination and cooperation between all relevant actors.
