Subject: Electoral Act for European Parliament elections

The German Constitutional Court has repeatedly rejected the implementation of an electoral threshold for the European elections on the ground that it would constitute a violation of the right to equal suffrage, which is enshrined in the German constitution.

Does the Commission consider it necessary to measure Council Decision 2018/994 of 13 July 2018 amending the Electoral Act for European Parliament elections against the rights enshrined in the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union (Article 39)?
