Subject: Financial penalties for Member States

Every year, the Commission receives penalty payments from Member States, for example, as a result of infringement proceedings or the non-transposition of directives. The amount of revenue collected is then deducted from all Member States' gross national income-based contribution, including the Member States obliged to pay penalty payments.

- 1) What amounts in penalty payments has the Commission received annually from each Member State respectively from 2004 until today?
- 2) How high were the yearly deductions from the gross national income-based contribution resulting from the collection of penalty payments for each Member State respectively from 2004 until today?
- 3) What penalty payments remain outstanding from 2004 until today, and how does the Commission go about collecting the payments from the Member States?
