Subject: Implementation of the 'one in, one out' principle

As part of the Better Regulation agenda, the Commission conducted a pilot project in 2021 in order to implement the 'one in, one out' principle when preparing new legislation. The pilot project included a calculator for internal use. In 2022, this principle was expanded and applied to all relevant legal proposals.

- 1) Does the Commission intend to make its 'one in, one out' calculator available to other EU institutions or the public, and if not, why not?
- 2) Could the 'one in, one out' calculator be applied to legal proposals from 2021 that were not included in the pilot project and from other earlier years, and if not, why not?
- 3) What are the respective adjustment and/or administrative costs for the legal proposals presented by the Commission since the beginning of its mandate?
