Subject: Support to refurbish and renovate the facilities at INATEL's Santo da Serra Holiday Centre

The Santo da Serra Holiday Centre – facilities owned by the INATEL Foundation in the Autonomous Region of Madeira – has been closed since 2008. It has an excellent location and great potential for tourists looking to escape the coastal cities in favour of the peace afforded by less urbanised and more natural areas.

For several years, regional INATEL managers have been looking for ways to reopen and enhance the value of these facilities. To this end, it is necessary to refurbish and renovate the facilities, which, having been closed for more than 14 years, show signs of wear and tear. Their reopening would, among other things, enable the creation of about three dozen jobs.

The INATEL Foundation's aim is to improve conditions for people looking to practise hobbies and leisure activities. In 2008 it ceased to belong to the central State administration, becoming a private foundation of public benefit.

In view of this:

1. What EU funds can the INATEL Foundation and/or the Autonomous Region of Madeira draw from to refurbish and renovate facilities at the Santo da Serra Holiday Centre?
