In the four years from 2016 to 2019, the Commission evidently spent more than EUR 462 million on contracts with the big four consultancy firms: PWC, KPMG, Deloitte and EY. The McKinsey consultancy was a further Commission contractor.¹ In particular under the Commission's Structural Reform Support Programme, the number of consultancy contracts increased rapidly after it was launched in 2017.
