Subject: EU Commissioners' air travel

The Commissioner for Climate Action, Frans Timmermans, is aiming to put an end to short-haul flights within the European Union, as he announced in May 2021: there should be no more short-haul flights for distances of less than 600 to 800 kilometres in the EU¹. To support this goal, in 2021, Commission President von der Leyen flew from Vienna to Bratislava by private jet (duration: 19 minutes, distance: 47 km)².

- 1. What was the Commission's total spending on flights between 2020 and 2022?
- Which Commissioners took flights for work-related travel for distances of less than 800 km between 2020 and 2022?
- 3. How many tonnes of greenhouse gases were emitted owing to Commissioners' air travel between 2020 and 2022?
