Subject: State of play of preparations for Hungary's Council Presidency

Hungary is scheduled to hold the rotating Council presidency for six months from 1 July 2024. In its resolution of 1 June 2023, the European Parliament already expressed its concerns about how Hungary would be able to fulfil this task credibly in view of its failure to comply with EU law and the values enshrined in Article 2 of the Treaty on European Union, as well as with the principle of sincere cooperation.
