Subject: The UK's participation in Eurosur and support for Frontex

Even after Brexit, the UK wants to cooperate with Frontex at strategic level. The UK Government is also requesting access to data from the Eurosur border surveillance system. The Commission is holding discussions about an agreement in relation to this matter.

1. What forms of cooperation with Frontex and its fundamental rights monitors is the UK Government proposing, and what proposals for financial contribution towards Frontex's activities is the Commission aware of?
2. To what extent is the UK Government also requesting access to information from Eurosur, and to what extent, according to the request, is this information also to be used for the prosecution of cross-border crimes (i.e. not solely for English Channel migration control and maritime infrastructure surveillance)?
3. To what extent is the UK Government offering Frontex and the EU Member States information from air or space surveillance in return, and for what purposes could this information supposedly be used?
