The motto of the European Union is 'United in Diversity'. In this respect, the preservation of linguistic diversity has been, and remains, a principle of importance to the European project and one guaranteed by the Treaties and EU legislation.

However, if one examines the Commission's websites and documents, it is clear that there is insufficient translation into Romanian, which can only result in poorer awareness of the European Union and lower levels of confidence in the EU institutions.

In this connection, and on this, Romanian Language Day, I would like to ask the Commission for the following information:

- 1. What is the level of coverage of Commission documents and online platforms in Romanian, through translation into that language?
- 2. What steps has the Commission taken to ensure that the Romanian language is well represented in the work of the EU institutions, and in the documents they publish?
