Governments have concluded binding agreements with the World Economic Forum Subject:

(WEF)

Publications show that the Dutch and Flemish governments have concluded binding agreements with the World Economic Forum (WEF). Their national parliaments were not informed about these agreements. This raises great concerns as the WEF pursues a globalist and anti-democratic agenda. The governments are obliged, through these agreements, to implement this agenda.

- Has the Council or its representatives entered into any sort of agreement or arrangement (in the broadest sense of the word) with the WEF and/or any of its representatives?
- Can the Council indicate if it knows about individual Member States, EU regions or municipalities that have entered into any agreement and/or arrangement with the WEF and/or any of its representatives, and if so, what knowledge it has of such agreements and/or arrangements?
- Following on from questions 1 and 2, can the Council provide all details regarding the nature of any agreements/arrangements into which it has entered or about which it has knowledge, all communication (written and oral) regarding these agreements/arrangements, and the underlying considerations of, as well as the obligations and consequences resulting from, these agreements/arrangements?
