Subject: What EU initiatives can help prevent a humanitarian disaster in Nagorno-Karabakh?

In his answer to our question on support for Armenia after further bloody aggression by Azerbaijan in September 2022, the Vice-President of the Commission / High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy Josep Borrell stated that the EU was continuing its efforts to bring about a comprehensive settlement to the conflict¹. He referred in particular to the deployment of the EUMCAP². That mission ended in December³. In January, the European Council agreed to set up the EUMA⁴ with the aim of helping to stabilise border areas and normalise relations between the two countries⁵. Since July, however, and despite its promises, the Azerbaijani Government has refused entry to humanitarian convoys⁶. For nine months now, the 120 000 Armenians in Nagorno-Karabakh have been suffering from shortages of food and medical supplies.

An EU spokesperson⁷, like the Azerbaijani dictatorship and Turkish President Erdoğan, has condemned the democratic presidential elections held by the Armenians in Nagorno-Karabakh on 9 September. Bearing that in mind, what steps does the Commission intend to take to provide specific assistance to Armenians who are under threat in the region, in spite of the recent gas deal that Azerbaijan and the EU have concluded⁸?
