Subject: Frontex drone crash

On 24 August 2023, a European Border and Coast Guard Agency (Frontex) drone fell into the sea 70 nautical miles south-east of Crete. The Heron 1 drone, manufactured in Israel, is said to have lost satellite communication with the ground station for unknown reasons.

- 1. Who is in charge of investigating the crash and when will any reports be available?
- 2. What are the preliminary findings of Frontex concerning the cause of the crash?
- 3. Can the Commission provide a detailed breakdown of the costs incurred to date by Frontex resulting from the contracts for the operation of a drone based in Malta and a drone based in Crete, and what other costs are forecast?
