Subject: Seahorse Mediterranean network participants

The EU Seahorse Mediterranean programme aimed to involve countries such as Tunisia and Libya in the EU's existing Seahorse Mediterranean network, which was set up by Mediterranean countries such as Italy, Malta, Cyprus and Greece to exchange information on events in the Mediterranean Sea.
