Question for written answer E-002950/2023 to the Commission Rule 138 Filip De Man (ID)

Subject: Giving away EU furniture to IMPACT Furniture (Oxfam) (2)

The Commission donates office furniture from various EU buildings, free of charge, to IMPACT Furniture, a commercial service that is part of the left-wing NGO Oxfam, which, as a result of selling that furniture, inter alia, bequests, membership dues and grants, recorded a massive profit of over EUR 6 million in 2022 and had a net worth of more than EUR 18 million. The cost of clearing buildings and of removals is also reportedly borne by the Commission.

- 1. What was the cost to the Commission of clearing the buildings and moving the furniture?
- 2. Does the Commission not think that this constitutes unfair competition vis-à-vis private-sector firms that are being priced out of the market in this way?
- 3. Does the Commission not think that giving away office furniture bought with taxpayers' money is an unacceptable waste of taxpayers' money?
