**Subject:** Palestinians granted asylum in the EU rejoice at Hamas' indiscriminate attack on innocent civilians

In the wake of Hamas' unprecedented aggression against women and children, video footage from the refugee centre on Samos and other islands has been circulating on the internet showing so-called refugees, the majority of whom claim to be persecuted by Hamas, cheering in response to the organisation's terrorist attack against Israel. Muslim channels circulated the footage on social media. These images reveal a dangerous reality which transcends the long Israeli-Palestinian conflict and proves that pockets of Islamic terrorism have formed within the EU and all they are waiting for is the green light from their leaders to bring bloodshed to Europe's capitals, to rape and massacre innocent citizens. Clearly, if they were able to launch such a devastating attack in Israel, a country that is so well guarded, the consequences of a potential attack within the EU, where they roam freely under the guise of refugees, will be even more dire.
