Subject: Amazon – competition rules

The US Federal Trade Commission has filed a lawsuit against Amazon for overcharging customers and independent sellers on its platforms to maintain monopoly power. Amazon has been accused of forcing sellers to increase their prices when using the platform. In addition, it is reported that Amazon has developed a pricing system known as Project Nessie, leading to unfair competition.
