Subject: Change to electoral law ahead of European elections

According to reports in the Greek press, the Greek government intends to change the electoral law ahead of the European elections, establishing five or six regional constituencies instead of the single one currently in existence. Given the reports on rule of law breaches in Greece, the manipulation of justice/the judiciary and the control exercised over the media, can the Commission answer the following:

1. What is the proper time for changes of this kind to be made ahead of European elections, bearing in mind that such changes could affect voter habits?
2. Is the establishment of additional constituencies in line with the principle of proportionality that applies to European elections?
