Subject: Clarification concerning Iran's increases to its enriched uranium stockpile

According to a recent study by the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), following developments in the conflict in Palestine, the Iranian regime has added to its enriched uranium reserves.

According to the study, the increase appears to be 22 times higher than the ceiling authorised in the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA), the treaty signed by Iran under which it committed to limiting its uranium reserves in exchange for the lifting of international sanctions against it.

In the light of the above:

1. Is the Commission aware that the Iranian regime has added to its enriched uranium reserves?
2. What steps will it take if the increases turn out to be higher than the maximum limit authorised in the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action?
