Subject: Funding of Tunisian authorities under the MoU of 23 July 2023

The memorandum of understanding (MoU) signed with Tunisia in July 2023 includes EUR 105 million to help support the Tunisian authorities' migration and border management programme.

1. Has part of this funding already been disbursed to Tunisia?
2. Can the Commission confirm the following total expenditures: EUR 8 million for the UN Refugee Agency (UNCHR), EUR 13 million for the International Organization for Migration (IOM), EUR 18 million for the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) and UNODC partners, EUR 4 million for the Tunisian authorities, EUR 17 million for search and rescue (SAR) (through Civipol, a French agency under France's Ministry of the Interior) and the German development agency (GIZ), EUR 30 million for the International Centre for Migration Policy Development (ICMPD) and EUR 18 million for the procurement of new boats?
