Subject: Update of the EU regulation on Civil aviation to include UAP reporting

Considering Commissioner Breton's reply to the parliamentary question E-002375/2023(ASW)¹, which states that 'the collected safety occurrence reports are stored in a central repository and analysed for safety purposes only. Reporting, storing and analysis of civil aviation occurrences are governed by Regulation (EU) No 376/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 3 April 2014 on the reporting, analysis and follow-up of occurrences in civil aviation²', could the Commission please state:

1. Whether it considers updating the current legislation, namely Regulation (EU) No 376/2014 of 3 April 2014, to encompass the reporting, analysis and management of unidentified aerial phenomena (UAP)?
2. How a scientific and harmonised UAP reporting system could be established across the EU Member States for civil space and aviation, with a central EU repository for data acquisition, handling, analysis and public reporting?
3. If a future harmonised EU reporting system will ensure a participatory, transparent and stigma-free structure for space, civil and military personnel, agencies and institutions?
