Question for written answer E-000375/2024 to the Commission Rule 138 Gianna Gancia (ID)

Subject: Stepping up the fight against gender-based violence

Gender-based violence remains one of the most persistent and devastating human rights violations, with far-reaching implications for individuals, families and societies.

The Commission has adopted significant measures, such as the proposal for a directive to combat violence against women and domestic violence and establishing an EU network to prevent gender-based violence.

Despite these major efforts, challenges remain regarding the uniform implementation of policies, awareness-raising, victim support and accurate data collection.

Can the Commission answer the following:

- 1. How does it intend to expand and deepen education and awareness-raising programmes to address the cultural and social roots of gender-based violence, taking particular care to involve men and boys in these?
- 2. What additional measures are planned to strengthen support for victims of gender-based violence in terms of the accessibility and quality of legal, psychological and emergency accommodation services in all Member States?
- 3. How does the Commission plan to improve data collection and analysis on gender-based violence to inform more effective and evidence-based policies?
