Subject: Reporting requirements

Commission President von der Leyen promised to reduce reporting requirements by 25 %, in line with the Commission's strategy to boost the EU's long-term competitiveness and to provide relief for SMEs. The Commission is asked to answer each of the following questions separately and directly:

- 1. By how many percentage points have the reporting requirements been reduced by so far?
- 2. Does the Commission know how many duplicate reporting obligations currently exist in EU law? If so, how many? If not, why not?
- 3. Does the Commission know how many of the reporting obligations envisaged by EU law are also required under Member States' national laws, thereby resulting in duplicate reporting obligations? If so, how many? If not, why not?
