Plans to introduce an EU-wide cash limit of EUR 10 000 and an ID requirement for amounts of EUR 3 000 or more are giving rise to concerns over the restriction of civil liberties and the possibility of a cash ban being brought in through the back door.

- 1. Is there conclusive evidence or are there any studies proving that such a cash limit would be effective in combating money laundering and the financing of terrorism?
- 2. How can it be ensured that the measures do not unduly impinge upon citizens' privacy and civil liberties?
